## Tomahawk News

Bear safety will be covered at the August 1<sup>st</sup> meeting and all Scouts attending Tomahawk are required to attend.

Some rules about bear safety:

Keep campsites clean – trash left around the campsite can attract bears and raccoons aka “mini-bears”

No food in tents – not even empty wrappers or soda cans!

Other “smellables” – deoderants, shampoos, toothpastes, bug spray, etc. Keep them out of your tents as bears are attracted to these odors. All smellables should be packed in a plastic shoebox labeled with your name.

Personal hygiene – If you’ve spilled food on your clothing, don’t wear that clothing to bed or store it in your tent. Keep clean, but it is a better idea to shower in the morning or earlier in the day rather than the evening so the scents of personal hygiene products have time to wear off.

These are just a few things to remember. More information including what to do in the event of a bear encounter will be covered at the meeting.
